- The year 2022-23 has been a successful year for our college. We have completed the II cycle of accreditation of NAAC with a CGPA of 3.2 that is 'A' grade. The University Grants Commission (UGC) has extended the autonomous status of P.K.R. Arts College for Women for a period of 10 years from 2023-24 to 2032-33.

#### **Item 1: Action taken on the suggestions made in the previous Academic Council meeting on 30.07.2022.**

- ❖ It was accepted and approved.

#### **Item 2: Confirmation of the minutes of the last meeting held on 30.07.2023**

- ❖ The Principal sought approval and confirmation of the minutes of the last meeting of the Academic council which was held on 30.07.2022. It was accepted and approved by the council members.

#### **Item3: To scrutinize and approve the rules and regulations for the students admitted in all UG and PG programmes and branches from the academic year 2023-2024 and onwards.**

- ❖ It was accepted and approved by the members.

#### **Item 4: To scrutinize and approve the implementation of Outcome Based Education(OBE), the Question Paper pattern with knowledge level & Distribution of marks based on Bloom's Taxonomy for all UG and PG programmes based on new pattern for the students admitted from the academic year 2023-2024 and onwards.**

- ❖ The General Body Nominee, Dr. B. Vanitha, Former Registrar, Bharathiar University Secretary, KG College of Arts and Science, Coimbatore, She questioned the Cos& Pos mapping methodology and knowledge level for UG & PG. Course objective has to be written from teacher's perspective.

- ❖ The resolution was passed. It was seconded by Dr. P. Natesan, Head & Dean, Department of Commerce and the members of the council approved.

**academic year 2023-24 and onwards and also in Semester – IV, VI for all UG Programmes 2022-23 in the academic year 2023-24.**

- ❖ Dr. B. Vanitha suggested to include some topics based on TANSCHÉ syllabus and the Principal replied that Bharathiar University postponed the implementation of TANSCHÉ syllabus to the academic year 2024-25.
- ❖ The resolution was passed. It was seconded by Dr.G. Umamaheswari, Head Incharge, Department of Tamil, and approved by the council members.

**Item 10: To scrutinize and approve the inclusion of Language courses Tamil – III, IV English – III, IV in semester III, IV in BBA, All Commerce and All Computer Science where it was not there earlier and also the ratification of Language courses Tamil – III, IV, English- III, English-IV in semester III, IV in B.A. (Tamil Literature), B.A. (English Literature), B.Sc (Mathematics) and B.Sc (Physics) Programmes in the academic year 2023-24 for the students admitted during 2022-23.**

- ❖ The resolution was passed. It was seconded by Dr.M.Kasthuri, Head, Department of Mathematics and the council members approved.

**Item 11: To scrutinize and approve the External Examination pattern is converted into Internal Examination Pattern for Foundation Courses, Ability Enhancement, Non-Major Elective and Skill Enhancement Course is Internal Examination only from the academic year 2023-24 and onwards.
