



Item 5: To scrutinize and approve the pattern of examinations with Internal 25 marks and External 75 marks in lieu of 50:50 respectively for the students admitted in all UG and PG Programmes from the academic year 2023-2024 and onwards.

- Dr. B. Vanitha suggested to mention the reason for change of pattern. But the Principal explained that as per the instruction from the Bharathiar University, there is a change in the pattern of examinations.
- The resolution was passed. It was seconded by Mrs. R. Jayalakshmi, Dean of Academics, Department of Mathematics and the council members approved.

- * One of our University nominees, Dr. S. Suja, Professor & Head, Dept. of Biochemistry. Bharathiar University, Coimbatore suggested to provide place for conducting TNPSC
