Interchange the theory course of Linux and Shell Programming with another core paper, while keeping the Linux and Shell Programming - Practical course unchanged. 2. A recommendation is to merge the two core papers of Computer Networks & Network Security and Cryptography into a single course, and introduce a new core paper. This merging would allow for a more comprehensive understanding of the interplay between network security and cryptography concepts. Additionally, the addition of a new core paper would provide students with an opportunity to explore a different area of study and broaden their knowledge base.
