The Minutes of the previous year Meeting was read by the coordinator Dr. P. M. Gomathi, Associate Professor of Computer Science. The committee members evaluated the previous year activities.

Dr. D. Mythili, Principal, chaired the meeting. The following points were discussed in the meeting.

- To make the students to feel comfortable in the new environment, Student Induction Programme for the first year U.G. and P.G. students will be organized.
- To provide self employability opportunities for the students, EDC has planned its activities for the current academic year. Part Time Jobs are also provided for economically weaker section of students.
- To cater to the needs of the students the management has planned to upgrade the Cooperative Store and Canteen.
- To assist the students to have strong academics and emotional well-being, personal counselling and mentoring are to be continued effectively.
- Placement Training and Career Counselling are planned to guide and motivate the students to get placement in reputed companies.
